I/We agree to submit to and be bound by Jamaica Kennel Club Limited Rules & Regulations in their present form or as they may be amended from time to time in relation to all canine matters with which the Kennel Club is concerned and that this entry is made upon the basis that all current single or joint registered owners of this dog(s) have authorized/consented to this entry. I/We also undertake to abide by the Regulations of this Show and not to bring to the Show any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the Show, or which is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare or to bring any dog which has been prepared for exhibition contrary to Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition. I/We agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the Kennel Club. I/We declare that where any alteration has been made to the natural conformation of the dog(s) the relevant permission to show has been granted by the Kennel Club. I/We further declare that I believe, to the best of my knowledge, that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Show regulations I/We will be responsible for the safe guarding my dog and will be not left unattended, unless it is in a kennel. I/We will also be responsible for any injury to third parties caused by my dog.

NOTE: Dog entered in breach of the Kennel Club Show Regulations are liable to disqualification whether or not the owner was aware of the breach.

Class Definitions

PUPPY CLASS

For dogs not under 24 weeks and not exceeding twelve months of age on the day of show. (24-52 weeks). A male which does not have two normal testicles located in the scrotum will, however, be eligible for entry in this Class only.

GRADUATE CLASS

For dogs of 24 weeks and over which have not won either a Challenge Certificate (CC) or Reserve Challenge Certificate (RCC) nor three or more first places (Puppy Class excepted) at any recognized Championship show in Jamaica or abroad.

N.B. All wins subsequent to the date of entry and prior to the date of the Show shall determine a dog's eligibility to exhibit in this Class. The fees paid for entry to this Class are not refundable.

OPEN CLASS

For all dogs of six months (24 weeks) of age or over providing that such dog has not accumulated fifteen (15) points inclusive of a Challenge Certificate.

CHALLENGE CLASS

This Class is for the Jamaica Kennel Club registered Champions only, who challenge the winner of the Open Class of its breed and sex.

CHILDREN'S HANDLING CLASS

For youngsters 6 years and under 11 years of age on the day of the Show.

JUNIOR HANDLING CLASS

For youngsters 11 years and under 16 years of age on the day of the Show.

N.B. As the judging for both the Children and Junior Handling Classes will be on the ability of the entrants to handle their dog and not of the dogs themselves, it follows that the winners of both classes DO NOT qualify for entry into either Honours Class or Best Puppy Class.
